Legally mandated reporters: Will vary based on type of abuse. For example, financial institutions are mandated reporters of Elder Financial Abuse; whereas photo developers are mandated reporters of Child Sexual Exploitation. However, anyone who can be expected to encounter at-risk populations as a normal part of their job (medical, education, counselors, clergy, etc.) is likely to be required by law to report suspected abuse.
